

Activity Type

Grammar Activity: gap-fill, guessing (pair work)

Focus

Articles: *a*, *an*, *the*

Aim

To practice completing sentences with articles and words.

Preparation

Make one copy of the two worksheets for each pair of students.

Level

Elementary (A1-A2)

Time

25 minutes

Introduction

In this articles activity, students guess missing articles and words in sentences.

Procedure

Divide the students into pairs (Student A and B).

Give each student a corresponding worksheet.

Tell the students not to show their worksheet to their partner.

Students then take turns reading a sentence to their partner using the word 'blank' for the words in bold.

Their partner listens and completes the sentence by saying a word from the box on their worksheet along with a suitable article (*a*, *an*, or *the*).

If their partner replies with the correct article and word shown in bold, the student scores one point in the box.

The student with the most points at the end wins.

Student A
